Call to order

At 7:05pm Angela Kobylecky called the meeting to order.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

VICE PRESIDENT'S REPORT - Denise Cowett & Kristen Gartrell

Current membership 16, Donor total \$875. *Last year 29 members, Donor Total \$4,025* Reasons? So many unknowns due to pandemic, no registration packets went out, back to school events were cancelled, and the graduated seniors.

TREASURER'S REPORT - Tammi Sowinski

Current Balance and Revenue and Expenses Report

Board agreed to use the budget from last year as is due to all unknowns. In regards to the current balance we ended last year \$2,800 positive due to lack of expenses from the Spring musical. We will take this into consideration when funding this year's wish lists.

Debra Nowak moved and Angela Kobylecky seconded the budget

2020-2021 COMMITTEE CHAIRS AND REPORTS:

AD SALES: Phil Walker

There are 9 new advertisers. Geneva Commons and Little Traveler could not place ads this year due to pandemic. Currently there are 10, possibly 11 ads in programs for Freshman Fall Play. Total revenue \$1,538. The amount received as of this meeting is \$770 (this includes a \$50 donation from Bruce and Willy's Natural Pet Food & Supplies). Board decided to run the ad for Bruce & Willy's Natural Pet Food & Supplies anyway due to their continued support of the Theatre Boosters. Last year ad sales totalled \$5340. Board decided to waive the requirement that we must have a check in hand before an ad runs in the playbill. Phil will continue to email and call local businesses.

THEATRE BOOSTERS' SOCIAL MEDIA, WEBSITE MASTER, QR CODES: Phil Walker

Phil stated the website was updated over the summer with 2 main goals: to make the website more user friendly/accessible by redesigning the layout and to make changes in the website security. The old website used HTML. It was switched to HTTPS which will increase the website security. There is a cost for the upgrade and an invoice will be sent to Boosters. Phil stated the new package has the option to include Google Suite applications and allows for 30 gigs of free storage. If we choose Microsoft there is an added fee. Angela Kobylecky told Phil to go ahead with the GSuite option.

Viking Revue will most likely be virtual. Phil was asked to create a virtual program and post the link to the website. Phil stated he will have digital copies to post.

Angela Kobylecky gave an update on Freshman play. Ms. Woodruff conducted a workshop on how to write bios for the playbills. Head shots were taken of all freshman participants. Parents will have access to head shots online. The same headshot will be used for the remainder of the year. Kim said she is coming back to take missing pictures. Kim Ayars will take pictures at the Dress Rehearsal on Thursday night starting at 5:30pm. She will also take pictures of tech and the show.

Jennifer Dodds related to the board that her son, Brendan Dodds did not have his headshot taken yet for the play. Angela Kobylecky said she would follow up with Kim Ayars to see if she can come in to take his picture.

FRONT OF HOUSE: Kristin Gartrell, Denise Cowett, Shannon Mccall

Attempts were made to look for an outside venue for Freshman play but none of the options were feasible. The production will be in the GHS auditorium. Shows will be on Friday and Saturday at 7PM. There are limitations to using the auditorium due to social distancing guidelines. Guidelines and space requirements only allow for 50 people to gather. This means 26 guests will be allowed to attend the show after taking the number of cast and crew into consideration.

The show will be recorded to share. Live streaming the show was considered, however the auditorium is not set up for it. It may be an option in the future but not for the freshman play.

On Thursday night for the Dress Rehearsal Booster Members who qualify for free tickets can attend as well as Geneva 304 staff members. Cast members can invite 2 people each night.

Last year, tickets for the freshman play cost: \$3 students, Adults \$5, seniors were free. Board wants ticket prices to be \$10 for students/seniors and \$15 for adults. Principal, Tom Rogers will have to approve pricing for tickets.

People will have to socially distance in the auditorium and seats are marked off where patrons are not allowed to sit.
