### New Business

- Paul Radinski and Stephanie Bellino our liaison's from the Board and was present for the meeting

    - Discussed how many playbills we should print
  - o A Sign Up Genius was created and sent out several times for concession items and volunteers
  - o Stephanie Tressemer is in charge of organizing the meals for Tech Week
  - o We need Cash boxes for Tickets, fanagrams and 2 for concessions
  - o No photos will be available
  - o T-shirts will be picked up on 10/28
    - They will be brought to the play on Monday
    - 25 were ordered
    - We comped 5 teacher t-shirts
    - Kids paid \$25 per shirt
  - If everyone pays we will lose \$25

### Treasurer Report

- Membership totals are not at projected revenue yet, we were anticipating \$2000, only \$1000 received so far
- Ad sales have exceeded projected budget revenue, we anticipated \$2000 and are currently at \$2,440
- Checkbook sales are going great, we've sold a little over half of the 300, we are at the break even point
  - o The Geneva Chamber of Commerce agreed to sell our checkbooks, we just have to get them to them
  - o True Value will also sell them for us
  - o We discussed selling them outside of Atlas/Preservation/Geneva Lutheran Church during the Christmas kick off
  - o We will sell them at the fall play
- We have earned \$15 from Amazon Smiles

#### Other Items

- End of the year banquet
  - o Need to decide if we keep last year's venue and if so let's book it
- Phil was not here but he is inundating social media to sell more tickets
- Tammy will work on the Cast Baskets for the fall play
- A discussion was held about possibly using push coin instead of ticket peak for ticket sales as we will save the fees
- The December meeting will be cancelled or possibly just the board will meet
