New Business

Vice President Report

- Front of house
 - o We will sell tickets
 - Roll the dice

Other Items

- Jay's report
 - o He is working on updated the display case we just need to get him the pictures
 - o The ITS induction ceremony will occur next spring probably in April
 - More students will be able to be inducted
- Theater Fest Update
 - o We have 2 adult drivers so they can use the mini bus to get to the U of I
 - o He will have the total cost by the end of next week, 21 kids and 2 adults going
 - o He will get us his wish list for the lighting gels and fill speakers
 - o The school told him there is an -\$9000 budget for the auditorium and he is looking into how that is possible
- *Hunchback of Notre Dame* is the musical that will be performed in the spring
 - o There will probably be room for about 40 actors
 - o We will ask the Music Boosters to contribute food one day during tech week for cast/crew
- Should we include a fee going forward for students participating in plays/musicals?

- Could include t-shirts, shout outs, food
- We could possibly then give back to the restaurants that donate food to us so generously
- Phil's report
 - There will be 3 full page ads in the Spring Musical's playbill in color including a back page ad
 - He is going to follow up with Country Meats and visit current sponsors to thank them and he will continue to pursue new donors
 - The new signs are 17 ½ inches tall and we need a place to safely store them
 - Phil could build a crate for them
 - He was going to add plastic to the back of the signs and then back light them so they would stand out even more
 - The Paramount Theater has offered to give us vouchers for upcoming shows to give away
- End of the Year Banquet
 - Amy Engerman will be helping and she is a sophomore parent
- We need to work with Andy Cozzi to get pictures for the musical, including head shots
 - Should we pay him and if so how much can we afford to give him
- A question was raised whether we should print individual pictures or offer a data dump for \$20
- We are still deciding whether to use Fagans for the playbills or create our own on the Playbill software
- We would like to once again use a student's graphic design for the posters
- There will not be a meeting in December due to the winter break
