





#### **Director's Notes**

The concept for *Noises Off* seems simple ... Present a play about a company of actors performing in a farce and what happens when their own lives become more farcical than the characters they are playing. However, there is nothing simple about *Noises Off*. For anyone not familiar with the basic structure of a farce, the author, Michael Frayn includes a lesson in "Farce 101" by allowing the audience in Act One to see the play within the play, *Nothing On*. There are slamming doors, mistaken identities, dropping trousers and more.

What happens in Act II and Act III is a lesson in timing, rhythm, and choreography. During my career, I have directed, acted in and choreographed many musicals; and I believe that farce and musicals are very closely related in this respect. Musicals require an audience to accept the convention that characters suddenly break into song, and farce asks an audience to believe that people in seemingly ridiculous situations are behaving normally. As someone once said, "Farce is very serious business."

I need to mention how much work this cast has put into a brilliant but challenging show such as this! They are a great group of young adults, and I have enjoyed every minute of this experience! I also need to thank the parents. This show could not have happened without their help and support!

I recently read a brilliant metaphor for this play in that it is like the Indy 500...Act I, the engines are revving up. Act II are the vehicles taking flight at a high rate of speed, and Act III, the wheels come off in spectacular fashion. So this evening, sit back in the passenger seat and enjoy what many call the funniest plays ever written.




