

Director's Notes



Hello, Everyone, and welcome to Geneva High School's production of H2\$ - This is, in my opinion, one of the best satirical musical comedies. The songs are original and appealing, the dialogue is sharp-witted, the plot is engaging and fast-paced. Underneath the humor of the superbly funny script, How to

Succeed in Business Without Really Trying is, of course, a scathing send-up of corporate culture circa 1960. Its biting social commentary is as timely now as it was then, and it remains a refreshing reminder of some of the great work that came out of the mid-20th century musical comedy genre.

It's just as refreshing to have a great big cast back onstage. Paired with a large crew and orchestra, this production has been the most normal I've felt in the theatre in about two years, and I am grateful for it. I'm grateful also for Mr. Aucella, Ms. Palmisano, Mr. Frederick, Ms. Fritz, Mr. Donahue, and Ms. Nemeth for their time and effort in making this large-scale musical a reality.

I leave you with the words of the talented Marc Bruni: "Ultimately, the brilliance of How to Succeed lies in its timeless understanding of human nature within the corporate system and its sparklingly witty Frank Loesser score. As we watch Finch lie and charm his way up the ladder without repercussions – ultimately setting his eye on politics – perhaps the real accomplishment of the show is not as a time capsule but as a prophecy."
