






There are few holiday tales as famous and influential as A Christmas Carol. Even if you've never read the original, there are countless versions and adaptations that you've probably been exposed to, perhaps without knowing it. It makes regular appearances each year in sitcoms and other TV shows, so much so that we're more familiar with the various interpretations of it than the actual story. Why is this? What has captivated us so much that over 180 years later, we're still telling this story every season? Like any piece of enduring art, the answer is in the theme. The idea that even the hardest among us can be redeemed, is something that has resonated throughout time. It speaks to our nature as humans: we can behave terribly to each other, but deep down we still believe in the goodness of humanity. Everyone loves redemption stories!

Charles Dickens created some of the most powerful and iconic characters in literature; the very name Scrooge has become a synonym for miser. Something that tends to get lost in many adaptations is the humor Dickens brought to his writing. In choosing this adaptation by Charles Ludlam, I felt that our students were particularly well-suited to bring that to forefront. This version has something for everyone: heart, humor, and horror! The students have worked incredibly hard to navigate all these waters, which is no small feat. I'm very proud of everything they have accomplished and the unique spins they've all brought to these towering characters. I hope you enjoy the show and have a very merry start to the holiday season!




