




Director's Note



It is said that J. Bruce Ismay's hair turned white overnight.

The Last Lifeboat tells the untold story of J. Bruce Ismay, the owner of the White Star Line at the time of the sinking of the Titanic, whose decision to save himself rather than go down with the ship made him the scapegoat for one of the greatest disasters of all time. The play suggests that Ismay had made enemies of powerful newspaper magnate William Randolph Hearst during their business dealings, and it was Hearst who spearheaded the spreading of misinformation. The papers simplified the tragedy by noting that there were many victims and plenty of heroes, but only one villain: J. Bruce Ismay. This widely accepted and demonizing version of Ismay's actions led to his ousting from the White Star Line and spending the rest of his days as a recluse, haunted by ghosts. Addressing the issues of corporate greed, survivor's guilt, and how the media can sway public opinion, this drama explores not only the tragedy itself, but the sensationalized trials and aftermath of the night that changed the world forever.

We hope you enjoy The Last Lifeboat, and as always, thank you for your support of the performing arts.
