




Director's Note




Louisa May Alcott was a woman many years ahead of her time. She was an independent woman long before that concept was tolerated. She was a professional writer, making her own way during a time when this was not merely difficult, but nearly unthinkable. Alcott introduces us to her passions through the character of Jo March, admittedly modeled after Alcott herself. This story of the famous March women -mother Marmee and daughters Meg, Jo, Beth and Amy, on their own in Concord, Mass. -was published in two parts, in 1868 and 1869. It still is embraced in part because Alcott's story, set with a Civil War background, is so relevant in contemporary times. In the play, Jo expresses her desire to "try my wings." This desire to live a passion-filled life is exemplified when the four sisters are acting out Jo's original melodrama, and later when Jo refuses to accept the rejections from small-minded publishers. While her family appreciated and loved Jo, the world took a much longer time to see what she had to offer. Indeed, "Little Women" is not afraid to make an issue of gender, namely asking how a young woman can find the path that leads away from society's expectations (wife and motherhood) and find the right way to make her mark and create something special on her own. Jo eventually found a willing partner in Professor Bhaer, who helped her bring to life all that was inside her.

May all my students try their wings.

We hope you enjoy Little Women, and as always, we thank you for your support of the performing arts.
