



The 2005 Broadway production, directed by James Lapine, was nominated for six Tony Awards, winning two, including Best Book. The musical was based on an original improvisational play called C-R-E-P-U-S-C-U-L-E created by Rebecca Feldman before turning it into the full length musical.

The adults are trapped as well in their childhood personas, trying to find where their next path in life will lead them.
